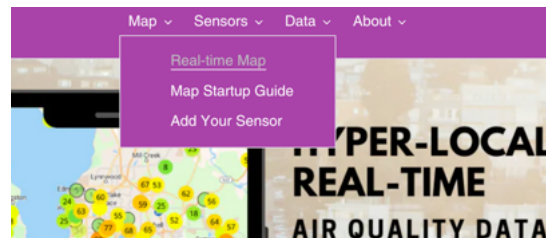
Welcome to CleanAIRE NC'S AirKeeper Program!

As a community scientist you play a critical role in making air quality data more accessible, accelerating research, and closing the data gaps in particle pollution to improve our understanding of local air quality.

Now that your sensor is up and running, you can use this guide to access your data.

Find Your Air Sensor

1. To find your sensor go to: www2.purpleair.com
2. From there you'll want to navigate to the Map tab and select **Real-time Map** (see image on right).
3. Once you are in the map, it should automatically zoom into your location. If this is not the case, navigate to the bottom right corner of the map and select the target (🎯) icon.
4. Find the circle on the map corresponding to your sensor name above and click on it.



See Your Air Quality

After clicking on your air sensor, a pop-up display will show you the current air quality reading in real-time.

You can also view your average air quality over a 10 minute, 30 minute, 1 hour, 6 hour, daily, and weekly interval, as seen in the example on the right.
